The session will be held Wednesday, March 18 from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. The purpose of the event is to provide parents with information on post secondary opportunities for their children. “Transition planning” is a coordinated set of activities focused on improving the academic and functional achievement of a student with disabilities to promote the students’ movement from school to post-school activities. These activities can include college, vocational training, employment, continuing and adult education, adult services, independent living or community participation. Transition planning is outcome oriented and focuses on results that help the student reach his or her post-school goals.
